David, who has used mostly acrylic paint in the past, has created his entire new collection in oil, which has allowed his bold use of color to make a dramatic impact on to the canvas. David co-owner of Modern Villa Galleries and Modern Villa Publishing lives and paints in Cannon Beach. The work of George Perrou will be making its debut to the art industry at this years ArtExpo. Perrou who was inspired as a young child by Warner Brothers and other animation from the 60's, has created his own style by imagining images he sees in 3D and then recreates those images on to the canvas, using retro colors in Acrylic. George lives and paints in Portland Oregon.

"People from all over the world will be in attendance to view the wonderful works of art from thousand of artist like David and George Perrou who have been helping ArtExpo define popular art for almost 30 years".
